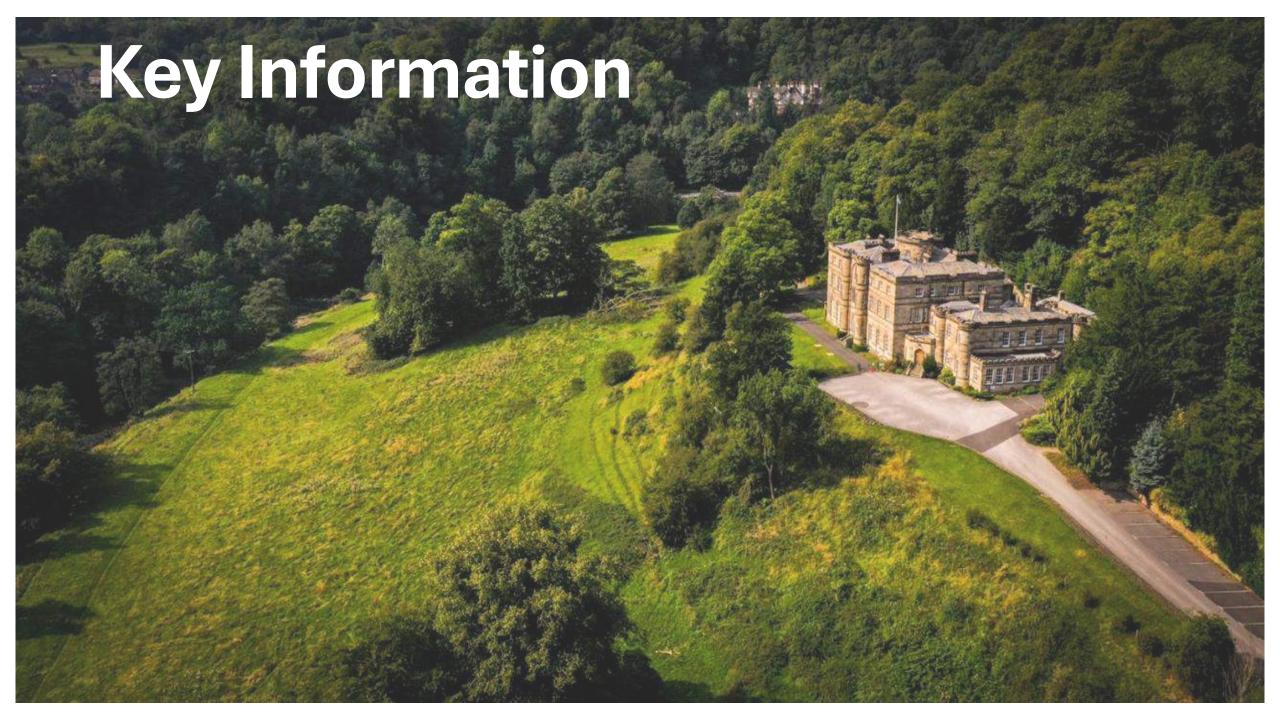

Key Times For Your Diary:

- Specific medication for trip must be brought into school by Thursday 23rd
 October (form will be sent home)
- Bus departs school @ 12:30pm on Monday 3rd November. Children will have lunch in school before leaving.
- Bus returns to school by **3pm on Wednesday 5th November.** Children will eat prior to departing Willersley Castle.
- School will inform parents/carers of children's safe arrival and provide regular updates including firmer ETA during return leg of the journey.
- Parents are welcome to wave the children off at time of departure but be mindful of traffic wardens.

- Closed-toe shoes (bring spares)

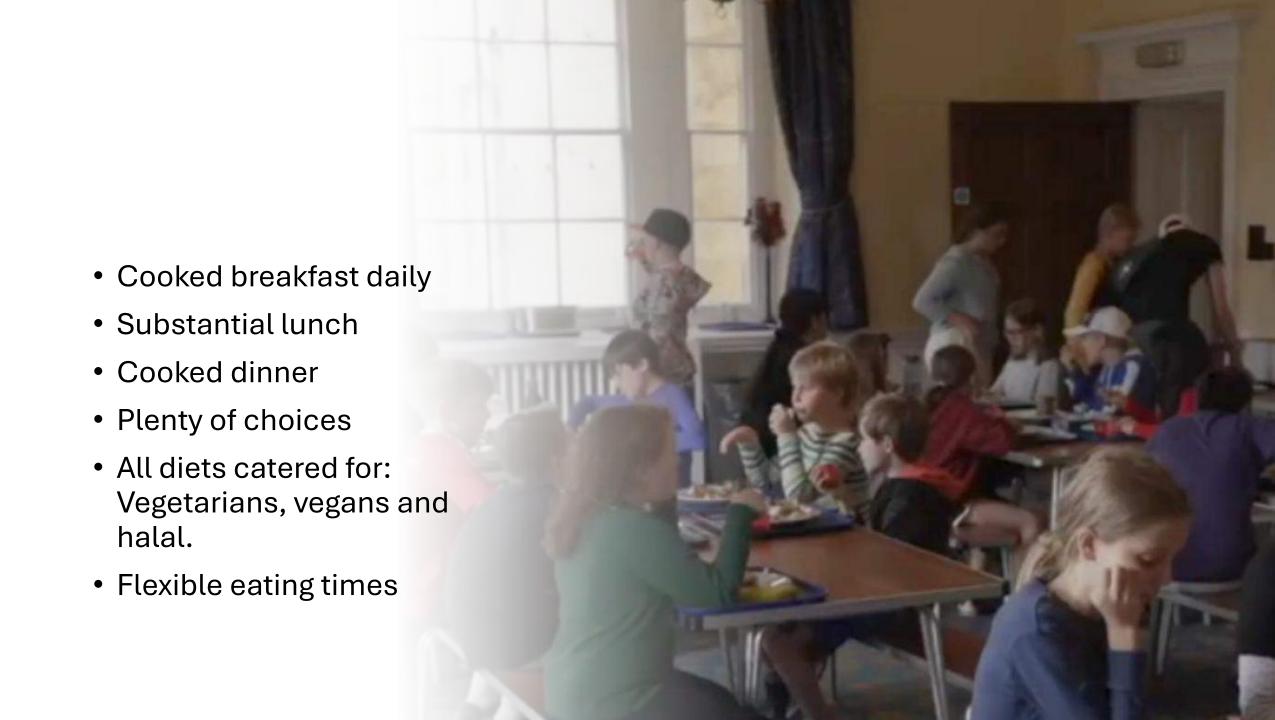
Useful Items

- No **food** on the coach

Dorms:
