After / Before School Clubs	<p>We are incredibly proud of the before and after-school sports provision we are able to offer pupils at Cannon Park. Special thanks to Mr. Beech, Miss Bullock and Liz Wilson (dance) for running the clubs, the children really enjoy taking part.</p> <p>This year we have offered the following clubs for pupils: football (Y1-6), hockey, games, basketball, netball, badminton, multiskills, dance, ball skills, athletics, cricket and rounders.</p>
After / Before School Clubs Participation	<p>Below is a breakdown of the pupils attending our clubs. Over half of our pupils have attended at least one sports club at Cannon Park School!</p> <p>Whole School – 53% Pupil Premium – 72% SEND – 38%</p>
Playtime and Lunchtime Sports Provision	<p>Our pupils love being active during playtime and lunchtime. They are incredibly lucky as Mr. Beech and Miss Bullock offer a range of sports on the playground every day. Miss Bullock has also conducted some pupil voice with the school council to help ensure the pupils have a say in the sports they are playing.</p> <p>This year, the children have been offered: football, cricket, tennis, basketball, hockey, athletics, endball</p>
Playtime and Lunchtime participation	<p>Participation in sport at playtime and lunchtime is celebrated weekly in our Friday assembly. Certificates are awarded for the class with the highest percentage of activity each week. Certificates are also awarded to individual pupils for their use of the Cannon Park Values during sports.</p> <p>Average Percentage of pupil activity – 72%</p>
Inter – school competition	<p>This year we have continued to participate in the School Games events as part of Coventry West. Pupils have taken part in the following events – Rounders, Speed Stacking, KS1 Agility, Sports Hall Athletics, HADO Augmented Reality Gaming.</p> <p>We have also continued to take part in competitive sports through the Coventry Primary School Sports Association. Our pupils have represented our school in Netball and Football matches. Our netball team have been particularly successful, winning the cup final against St John Vianney School!</p> 
School Games Mark	<p>This year, we have achieved the School Games Bronze Award!</p> 
Intra -school competition	<p>Our school sports day took place in June and was supported very well by our school community. 100% of children participated in our sports day.</p> <p>1st Place – “Daring Dragons” and “Raging Rhinos” 2nd Place – “Vicious Vikings” 3rd Place – “Crazy Cakes” Cannon Park Values Award – “Sporty Lions”</p>
Swimming	<p>Year 6 attended a swimming course to enable us to report on end of KS2 data.</p> <p>Pupils able to swim 25m – 60% Pupils able to swim a range of strokes – 53% Pupils able to perform self-rescue – 67%</p> <p>Year 4 pupils also enjoyed taking part in curriculum swimming lessons during the Autumn and Spring term.</p>
